Lansiwn ein tymor 2022-23 â Thrydydd Concerto Piano meistrolgar Rachmaninov. O'i thema agoriadol urddasol hyd y diweddgo sy'n rhythmig ddyrnu, allwch chi ddim llai na syrthio mewn cariad â'r ansawdd cerddorfaol moethus. Mae Rite of Spring Stravinsky yn gallu ein synnu a'n syfrdanu hyd heddiw, yn union fel y gwaeth yn ei première ym Mharis. Mae maint a ffyrnigrwydd y bale yn drawiadol, yn darlunio defod baganaidd – yn ystumiau onglog a symudiadau dan artaith a leddfir gan funudau o brydferthwch a llonyddwch sy'n ddrych o'r gwanwyn a bywyd newydd.

We launch into our 2022-23 season with Rachmaninov's virtuosic Third Piano Concerto. From its dignified opening theme to the rhythmically hammering finale, you cannot fail to fall in love with the lush orchestral texture. Stravinsky's Rite of Spring still has the power to shock and surprise, as it did at its premiere in Paris. Epic in scale and ferocity, the ballet depicts a pagan ritual – the angular contortions and tortured motions are countered by moments of beauty and stillness, reflective of Spring and new life.

Dyma un o ogonionau cerddoriaeth Lloegr ar ben rhaglen sy'n cynnwys tri chyfansoddwr mawr o Tsieciad. Mae Concerto Soddgrwth hyfryd Martinů yn heigio gan ddyfeisgarwch telynegol, yn cydasio idiomau gwerin Tsiecaidd ag eglurder Ffrengig, ac agorawd fer drawiadol ydi Jealousy y syniwyd amdani un tro ar gyfer opera Janáček Jenůfa. Ac iddi alawon cofiadwy ac uchafbwyntiau gwfreiddiol, mae Symffoni *From the New World* Dvořák yn curo gan yr egni a dynnodd o'i brofiadau Americanaidd yn Efrog Newydd York ac, yn y 'Largo' enwog, yn deffro yn y cof hiraeth y cyfansoddwr am ei famwlad Bohemia.

One of the crowning glories of English music heads a programme with three of the greatest Czech composers. Martinů's lovely Cello Concerto bursts with lyrical invention, fusing Czech folk idioms and Gallic clarity, while Jealousy is a short impactful overture that was once conceived for Janáček's opera Jenůfa. With memorable tunes and stirring climaxes, Dvořák's *From the New World* Symphony pulses with energy drawn from his American experiences in New York and, in the famous 'Largo', evoking the composer's longing for his native Bohemia.

Mae portreadau'r môr yng nghampwaith operatig Britten yn gyforiog o awrygylch, yn deffro atgofion ym mhwl y galon ac yn darlunio teimladau'n gelfydd. Swyn melodig sydd frenin yng nghasgliad gweddigar Dvořák o ganeuon o'r flwyddyn 1894, ac mae'r Preludio a'r Liebestod o opera Wagner – a berfformiwyd gyntaf ym Munich ym 1865, wedi'i seilio ar garwriaeth ddrwg ei thynged o'r ddeuddegfed ganrif – yn drwm gan gnawdolrwydd penfwdedol a dyheu corfforol. Greddfau theatraidd Janáček sydd amlycaf eu lle yn ffanfferau tanbaid ei Sinfonietta lachar ei sgorio, a'i seinfyd trawiadol sy'n dwyn y noson wefreiddiol i ben.

Britten's atmospheric sea portraits serve as visceral evocations and carefully drawn emotional states within his operatic masterpiece. Melodic charm pervades Dvořák's prayerful song collection from 1894, while a heady sensuality and physical longing saturate the Prelude and Liebestod from Wagner's opera first performed in Munich in 1865 and based on an ill-fated 12th century romance. Janáček's theatrical instincts come to the fore in the blazing fanfares of his vividly scored Sinfonietta, its striking sound world concluding a thrilling evening.

Yn ddifrifddwys, yn befrïol ac yn wefreiddiol yn eu tro, mae Preludio glasod Respighi yn waith wedi'i sgorio'n foethus sy'n ennyn diddordeb mwyfwy. O blith y dwsin o concerti mawr i'r piano a sgrifennodd Mozart o fewn tair blynedd pwysfawr yn Fienna, y pumed ar hugain ydi'r hwyaf ac un o'i fwyaf meistraidd. Mae ei fawredd a'i goethni'n gynneddfau mae'n eu rhannu â Symffoni'r *Organ* aruthrol Saint-Saëns – un o weithiau mwyaf arloesol y bedwaredd ganrif ar bymtheg lle mae ffurf a mynegiant wedi'u cyfuno'n odidog mewn gwaith a ystyrir yn frig ei orchesthon.

Variouly solemn, scintillating and stirring, Respighi's youthful Preludio is a richly scored work of accumulating interest. Of Mozart's dozen great piano concertos written within three momentous years in Vienna, the twenty-fifth is the longest and one of his most magisterial. Its grandeur and refinement are qualities shared in Saint-Saëns's mighty *Organ* Symphony – one of the most innovative works of the 19th century where form and expression are superbly combined in a work regarded as the pinnacle of his achievements.

Roedd Mahler yn dotio at fyd natur a'i anturiaethau yn yr awyr agored yn ei ysbrydoli. Yn ei nawfed symffoni yn anad unman y mae hyn ar ei amlycaf, ynghyd â'i ddiddordeb ysol mewn marwolaeth. Yn y symudiad cyntaf aruthrol, mae hyrddiau dwys yn dilyn adrannau gyda'r tyneraf, yr ail symudiad yn siglo gan ddawnsiau gwerin hamddenol a gosgeiddig, cyn y tywyllwch cythryblus sydd ben ar y trydydd. Mae'r symudiad cyntaf yn wledd i'r glust, a'r diwedd glo heb os nac onibai yn hafal iddo. Mae ei awyrgylch angerddol a'i dôn fyfyrion yn gadael argraff ddofn.

Mahler loved nature and found great inspiration in his outdoor adventures. This, combined with his preoccupation of the end, is never more evident than in his ninth symphony. Intense eruptions follow the most gentle of passages in the gargantuan first movement, relaxed and graceful folk dances lilt through the second movement, before a haunting darkness takes over in the third. If the first movement is something to behold, then the finale is certainly its equal. Its fervent atmosphere and reflective tone truly leaves a lasting impression.

Byth ers i John Wilson ei hail-lansio yn 2018, mae ei gerddorfa recordio enwog, Sinfonia of London, yn ysgubo'r byd clasurol. Dyma gerddorfa ddeddfol sy'n ymhyfydu mewn adolygiadau pum seren o bob tu ac yn y gamp ddi-gynsail, sef tair yn olynol o wobrau BBC Music Magazine. Mae un o enillwyr gynt Cerddor Ifanc y Flwyddyn y BBC, Martin James Bartlett, yn amlwg ei le yn Rhapsody in Blue jazzaid ei oslef Gershwin a'r rhaglen hefyd yn cynnwys darnau stondin cerddorfaol cymwys o drawiadol gan Walton a Debussy, a Boléro enwog Ravel yn ddiwedd glo sy'n codi'r galon yn ddiwrthdro.

John Wilson's Sinfonia of London has been taking the classical world by storm since he relaunched this famous recording orchestra in 2018. Basking in wall-to-wall 5 star reviews and with an unprecedented hat-trick of BBC Music Magazine Awards, this hand-picked orchestra is an unmissable highlight of this season. 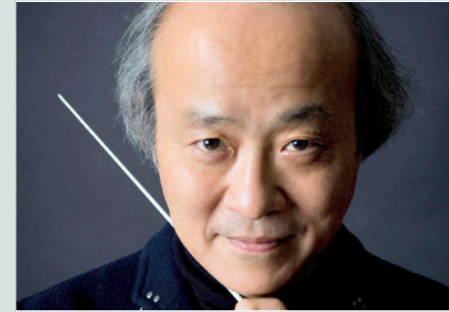

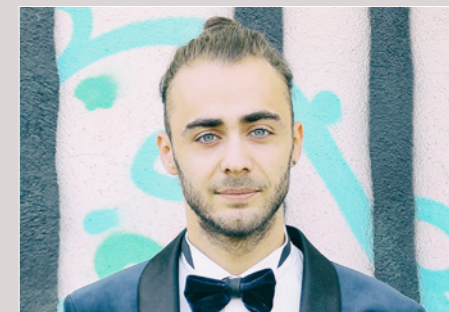

With luscious harmonies and the rhythmic characteristic of his later style, Rachmaninov's final complete composition, Symphonic Dances, uses motifs derived from Russian Church music alongside quotes from his own first symphony, creating a stirring mix of nostalgia versus the big city bustle and energy of 'Modern America'.

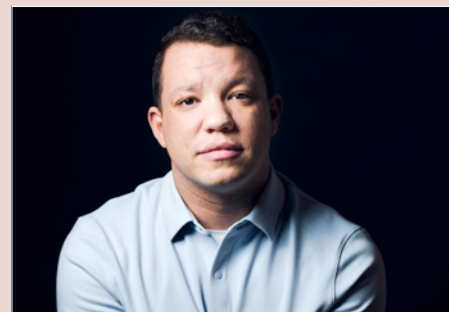

Un o gyfansoddwyr ifainc mwyaf cyffrous Sweden sy'n dwyn y noson i'w therfyn. Does dim dwywaith nad erys Paradisfåglar II Andrea Tarrodi yn fyw yn y cof.

Two of Sibelius's most atmospheric works bookend this enterprising programme: the nationalistic fervour of his Karelia Suite and the rugged beauty of his last symphony. Beethoven's rarely performed *Triple Concerto* provides an outstanding opportunity to hear three world-class soloists in a work of unexpected twists and turns and closing with a bravura finale. Completing the evening is a work by one of Sweden's most exciting young composers. You can be sure Andrea Tarrodi's *Paradisfåglar II* will leave a vivid impression.

Uncharacteristically Mozart in style, his 39th Symphony's slow and grand opening leads to an energetic allegro; a drifting andante bounds into the energetic Minuet, before jumping into the monothematic finale. Strauss often used a story to stimulate his musical imagination, and Don Quixote provides more than adequate food for thought. Featuring a solo cello as Don Quixote, and solo viola as his servant, Sancho, Strauss tells of the Don's many escapades in this slightly barmy 10 movement tone poem.

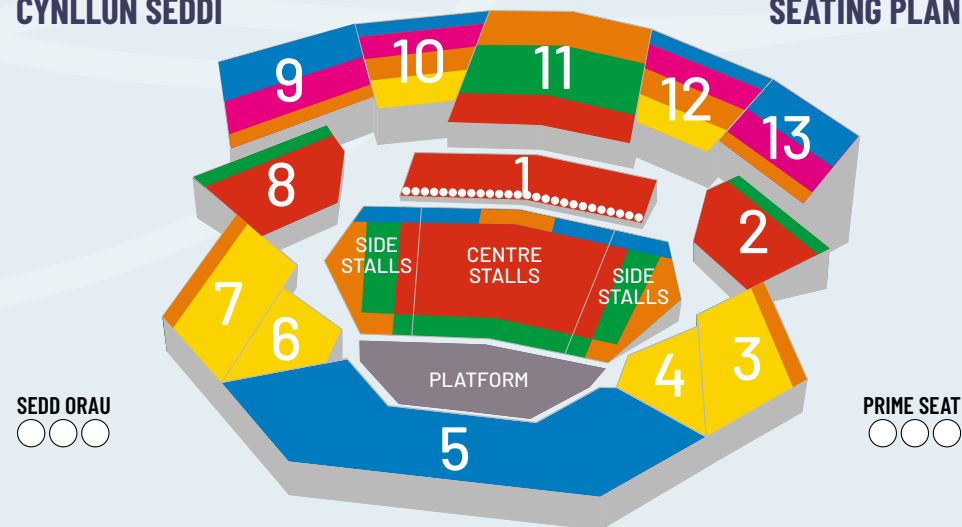

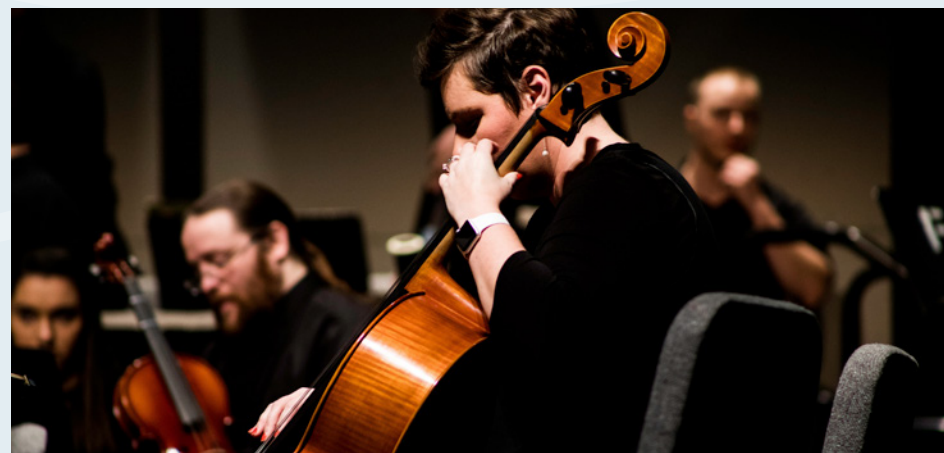
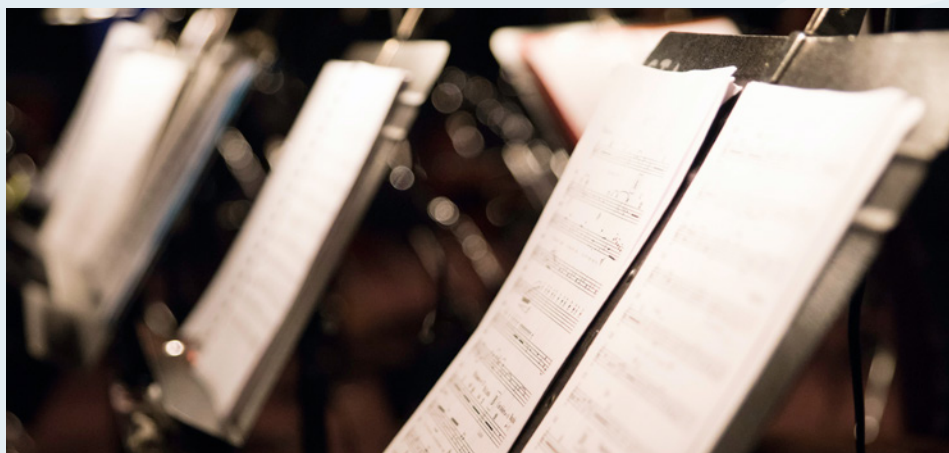
