Ym 1905 yn y Grand Hotel yn Eastbourne y cwblihawyd campwaith symffonig Debussy, yn llun cerddorol o'r môr yn dygyfor sy'n dal yn odiog chwarae'r goleuni ar ddŵr y Môr Udd. Mae Smetana yn deffro yn y cof yn galonogol gerhyntau chwyrliol a theimlad cenedlaetholgar yn llifo drwy Afon Moldau ym Mohemia, ei famwlad, ac mae un o'r concerti soddgrwth ceinfa a sgrifennwyd erioed yn adleisio'n hiraethus ysbryd mamwlad Dvořák ac yn talu teyrnged i'w gariad coll Josefina yn ei symudiad araf sydd fel cân.

Completed in 1905 at the Grand Hotel in Eastbourne, Debussy's symphonic masterpiece is a surging musical seascape wonderfully capturing the play of light on water in the English-channel. Swirling currents and national sentiment flow through Smetana's uplifting evocation of the River Moldau in his native Bohemia, while one of the finest cello concertos ever written wistfully echoes the spirit of Dvořák's homeland and pays tribute to his lost love Josefina in its central song-like slow movement.



a honnai fod ei "symffoniâu'n cynrychioli
cynnwys fy mywyd drwyddo draw". Mae
yna rai sy'n ystyried Trydedd Symffoni
Mahler ymhlið deg symffoni fwya'r
oesoedd - yn emyn arddunol i fyd natur,
a'i graddfa aruthrol, a lansir gan symudiad
agoriadol cyffrous, yn ymagor ag egni
teimladol mwyfwy ac yn dod i ben mewn
apotheosis sy'n ysgubo'r nef.

As the last great Romantic symphonist,
Mahler's music is conceived on the
grandest scale. Determined to express his
view of the human condition, he claimed
his "symphonies represent the contents
of my entire life". Regarded by some as
one of the ten greatest symphonies of
all time, Mahler's epic Third Symphony
is a sublime hymn to the natural world,
its ambitious scale, launched by a
barnstorming opening movement, unfolds
with an accumulating emotional energy
and culminates in a heaven-storming
apotheosis.

Yn ystod gwyliau haf ym 1878 y sgrifennodd Brahms ei Concerto Ffidil ac ers tro byd mae'n un o hoelion wyth y repertoire. Mae ar raddfa symffonig, yn waith sy'n tywynn gan heulwen yr Alpau, mawredd ysgythrog o bob tu Adagio awyr las a harddwch sidanaidd. Ar gopaon y concerto yma mae'r ffidler o Japan Sayaka Shoji, yr enillydd cyntaf o Japanead a'r ieuaf yng Nghystadleuaeth Paganini yn Genoa ym 1999. Mae Vladimir Ashkenazy yn berfformiwr o fri ym maes gwaith Sibelius felly does dim dwywaith na chlywch egni ffrwydrol yn yr Ail Symffoni fythol-boblogaidd.

Written during a summer holiday in 1878, Brahms Violin Concerto has long been a staple of the repertoire. Built on a symphonic scale, it's a work bathed in Alpine sunlight, rugged grandeur framing an Adagio of azure skies and silken-beauty. Ascending the peaks of this concerto is Japanese violinist Sayaka Shoji, the first Japanese and youngest winner at the Paganini Competition in Genoa in 1999. Vladimir Ashkenazy is a renowned Sibelius interpreter, so you can be confident of explosive energy in the ever-popular Second Symphony.




